- 9 forty pounds of like lawfull money of England to be paid to the Overseers of this
- my will for her use at her age of seaven yeares if shee soe long live if not
- equally to be devided betweene my other two daughters Alice and Elizabeth or to the longest
- 12 Liver of them But if they shall happen to dye before the time expressed in this my will Then
- my will is that my now wife Elizabeth shall enioy the said severall Legacies to her owne
- 14 proper use Item I give my sister Sara Pollard the wife of Henry Pollard of
- 15 Buckinghame the summe of twenty shillings to buy her a spoone to bee
- paid to them ymmediatly after my decease Item my will and desire is that my said

- of all and singular the goods chattells and debts of the said deceased shee
- being first sworne by Commision well and truly to administer the same Etc.
