1 In the name of God Amen =
2 The last will and testament of Thomas Hilton of Charndon in the parish
3 of Twyford in the County of Buckingham gent vizt: In primis I give and bequeath
4 my soule to Almighty god my Maker and my body to be buried according
5 to the disposing of my now wife if shee Survive mee Item I give and bequeath
6 to my two daughters Alice and Eliz: the summe of five poundes a peece of lawfull
7 money of England to be paid to them at their age of fourteene yeares if they shall soe
8 long live or to the longest liver of them Item I give to my daughter Mary the summe of
9 forty pounds of like lawfull money of England to be paid to the Overseers of this
10 my will for her use at her age of seaven yeares if shee soe long live if not
11 equally to be devided betweene my other two daughters Alice and Elizabeth or to the
12 longest
13 liver of them But if they shall happen to dye before the time expressed in this my will
14 Then
15 my will is that my now wife Elizabeth shall enjoy the said severall Legacies to her owne
16 proper use Item I give my sister Sara Pollard the wife of Henry Pollard of
17 Buckinghame the summe of twenty shillings to buy her a spoone to bee
18 paid to them ymmediatly after my decease Item my will and desire is that my said
19 wife shalbe sole executrix of the residue of my estate unbequeathed in this
20 my will and doe consitute and appointe my Cousen John Greene of Eynsham
21 in the County of [Oxfordshire] and Henry Pollard oforesaid to be Overseers of this
22 my will In Wittnes whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seale the 17th
23 day of May Anno D[omi]ni 1644. Item I give to my Cosen Eliz Greene twenty
24 shillings to buy her a ring to be paid to her ymmediatly after my decease Thomas
Hilton Acknowledged in the presence of us John Pollard Math: Wootton
Sara Pollard.

25 This will was proved at London the eight and twentieth day of June in the
26 year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred Fifty one before Sir Nathaniell
27 Brent Knight Doctor of Laws Master or Keeper of the Prerogative Court by
28 the oath of Elizabeth Bachelleres [*? Bathewes*] alias Hilton the Relict of the said
deceased
29 and Executrix named in the said will To whom was committed Administration
30 of all and singular the goods chattells and debts of the said deceased shee
31 being first sworne by Commision well and truly to administer the same Etc.
